NECESSARY LUXURIES

The design we need to make our lives and homes work. This month: Faucets take center stage.

Every day begins and ends at a sink. But for all its utility, the humble faucet is often an afterthought. Kallista's new Bezel collection makes a convincing case to change that. The American fixture company looked to Milan-based industrial design studio Buseti Garuti Redaelli and Italian manufac-

turer Cristina Rubinetterie for the collection. The results juxtapose natural stone—including Carrara marble, veined black Nero Marquina, and green Guatemala stone—with brass, crafting a soft-square profile faceted like a gemstone. Art Deco poise is merged with modern precision for a new take on taps. ■
